Fear Center is the story of a young college student, Kara Sharp, who accidentally encounters the murder of her friend and the fiend who just killed her. After a harrowing chase around the murdered girl's house, Kara escapes from the murderer who was intent on killing her—the only person who could tie him to the crime. Kara is found behind a dumpster by a homeless man and his dog. Kara is trembling and is repeating over and over only one phrase: "I can outrun you."

Kara is in deep shock and cannot communicate with anyone—the doctors, her parents or the police. After standard treatments all fail, Kara is seemingly in an irreversible catatonic state. Ultimately, the doctors recommend that Kara be treated with an experimental drug that impacts the brain's "fear center" and will remove all recollections of the trauma.

The parents agree to the treatment and Kara begins to recover but faces a long struggle to reclaim her life. As she becomes stronger, she is not happy with having part of her memory zapped—no matter how horrific the incident. She insists on being taken off the drug and accepts that she will have to face her demons. The ending of **Fear Center** has Kara once again facing the murderer who stalks her and to whom she once proclaimed: "I can outrun you!" Can she do it again?
